- Children must turn 3 years old on or before October 1, 2024. (No exceptions.)
- Parents/legal guardians must be residents of Bayonne.
- Placement in these programs will be made on a first come, first served basis in order of receipt of completed online registrations.

IMPORTANT

2 Step On-line Registration Process.

Visit www.bboed.org, click “Parents”, and then “Registration” to get started.

Step 1. Pre-Registration. Every student must be pre-registered for the **2024-2025** school year. After completion of Step 1, you will be given a confirmation number, which you will need for Step 2.

Please write it down. It will not be emailed to you. You will receive an email request to upload required documents, which must also be uploaded in Step 2. Click on the link for Step 2 for your child’s grade level during the appropriate time frame.

Step 2. Online Registration. In order to complete Step 2 you will need to have legible scanned full-page copies of the following: Birth Certificate, Parent ID, immunization records and 3 current proofs of address. You will also need to provide the last report card, transfer card and/or custody papers, if applicable.

Checklist for Registration:

(Please have clear scanned copies of all of these documents ready before you begin Step 2.)

- ❖ Birth Certificate and/or Passport
- ❖ Immunization record – front and back, must show student’s name, date of birth and must be in English
- ❖ Photo ID of parent or legal guardian
- ❖ Pre-Registration Confirmation Number for the 2024-2025 School Year
- ❖ Custody papers, if applicable
- ❖ Three (3) current proofs of Bayonne residency in parent/guardian’s name.

Acceptable proofs include documentation such as:

- PSE&G bill
- Cable TV/internet/phone bill
- Driver’s license or registration
- Water bill
- Property tax bill
- Credit card/bank statement
- Deed/mortgage statement
- Rental/Homeowner’s insurance
- Health insurance statement

Full Day Pre-K Frequently Asked Questions

What are the eligibility requirements for the Full Day Pre-K 3 Program?

Children must be 3 years of age on or before October 1, 2024. Children must reside in Bayonne, New Jersey. There are limited spaces available for Pre-K3. Students will be placed on a first come, first served basis in order of completed applications, with all required documentation included.

What are the locations of the Full Day Pre-K 3 Program?

Full Day Pre-K3 will be available at the above-mentioned facilities.

How many spots are available in the Pre-K3 Program for the 2024-2025 School Year?

There are 375 spots available for Pre-K 3.

How will my child's school location be determined?

During the application process, you will be asked to rank the schools in your order of preference. Once your application is complete and documents are verified, your child's placement will be determined based on your choices, and availability at that time.

Can I transfer my child to another location if my first preference is not assigned?

No. No transfers will be issued once placement has been determined.

What are the classroom requirements and support staff for Pre-K?

Each classroom is an inclusive environment with one P-3 certified teacher, and one classroom assistant. There are a maximum of 15 students in each class.

What are the school hours for the Full Day Pre-K Program?

The school hours for the program are determined by each provider, complementing the schedule of the Bayonne public schools in order to allow for pickup at their locations and Bayonne public schools in a timely manner.

Does attendance count in Pre-K?

Attendance counts and matters in Pre-K! Students are expected to attend school daily, unless they are ill. It is recommended that a doctor's note accompany their return if applicable. NJDOE defines Chronic Absenteeism as being absent 10% of the total expected days of school. This equals 18 days of instruction lost. **If a child is absent for more than 10 consecutive school days, the child will be removed from the program's enrollment.**

What is the Pre-K curriculum?

The Bayonne School District and its partners use the High Scope Preschool Curriculum, which is based on the principles of active learning and support of a child's positive interactions with adults and

peers. Our Preschool Curriculum is a comprehensive model that addresses all areas of development through eight content areas and 58 key developmental indicators (KDIs) — the skills and behaviors at each stage of development that pave the way for school and adult success. Each KDI is connected to and reinforced by scaffolding strategies to support and gently extend children’s learning.

What is rest time?

In a full day program, 3- and 4-year-olds, by law, must have a 40 Minute Rest Time in the daily schedule.

Does my child eat meals in school?

Students remain in their classroom for all meal times with a teacher. Individual provider flyers & directors will give details regarding lunch in their facility.

Will transportation be provided for students in the Full Day Pre-K Program?

No. Transportation will not be provided to the students in the program, unless indicated on the child’s IEP.
